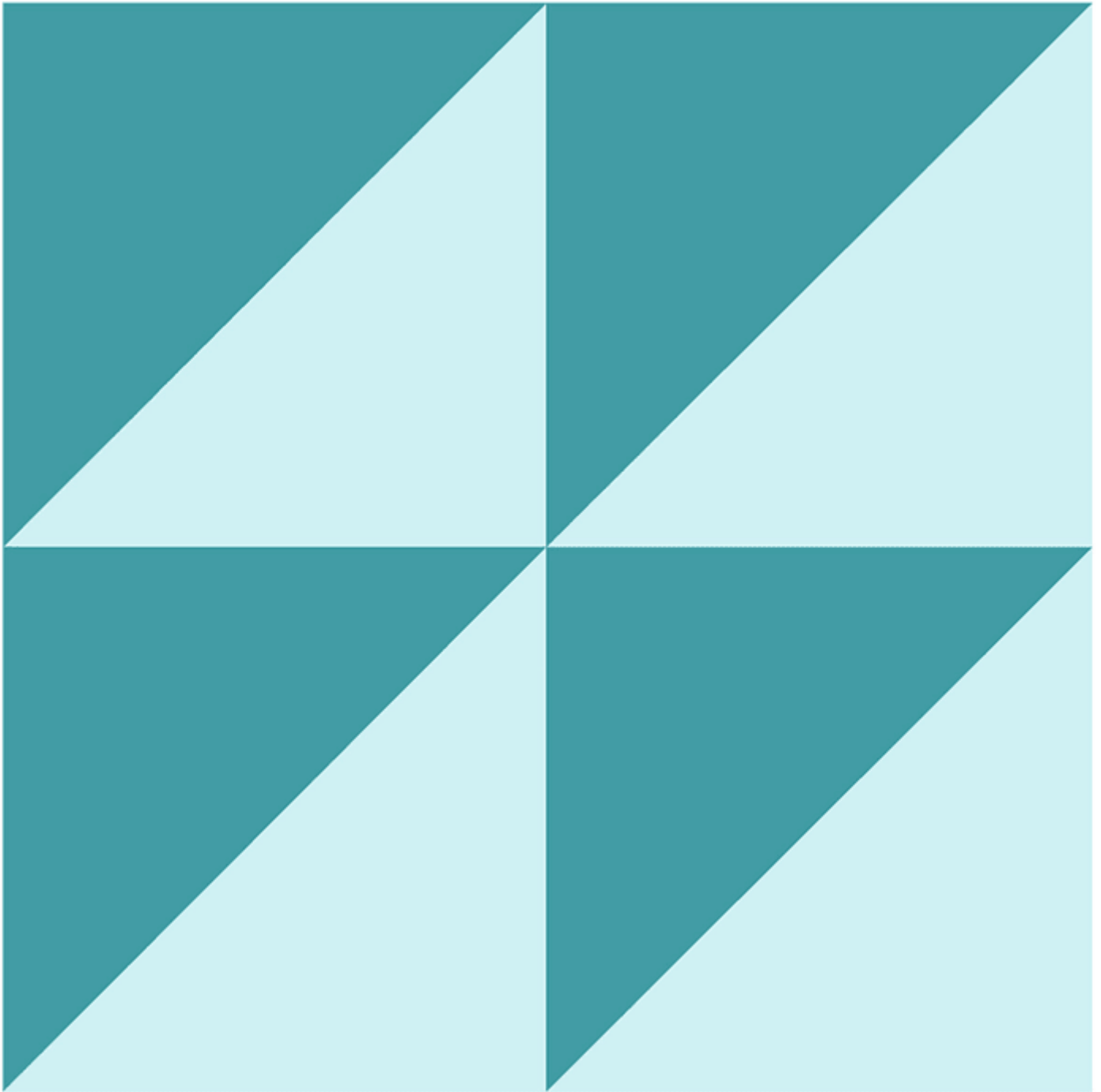

THE NAME ADVISOR FOR PEOPLE

There are many reasons you might want to analyze a name. Perhaps you are considering a name change or are expecting a child. In any case, it is important to recognize that the name you choose is only one part of the picture that determines who you will become.

A name is not unlike a blueprint. It reveals the talents, shortcomings, likes and dislikes, and a wide range of other traits, that were gifted on the day you received your name. Although your name may remain unchanged for decades, you evolve and change over time. This evolution begins with your date of birth. If a name change takes place later in life, it alters some of the traits and characteristics of the individual going forward, but the birth date and original birth name will continue to have the greatest impact.

In short, your name is YOU; your date of birth is YOUR PATH. Intertwined and co-dependent, every building block in a personality's DNA has the potential to change or disappear entirely, just as a missing quality can be learned or unlearned.

HOW TO READ THIS REPORT

No name is perfect. What you should look for are the specific strengths and talents you hope will benefit the person receiving the name.

If the name you are analyzing is for an unborn child, the report will only describe personality traits as reflected in the name you choose. Although it will be an incomplete picture (since the date of birth is unknown) it will still be a specific and detailed reading of the person about to be born.

The full name at birth describes their Personality, Hearts Desire, and Expression. If the child has already been born, use this Name Advisor to try a range of names. Once you have narrowed your choices, you may want to follow up with a complete Personality Profile, since you now also have the date of birth.

If you are considering a name change for yourself, the Name Advisor provides opportunities to try several names and variations. However, choosing a new name is not unlike buying a suit; it needs to fit. It is less important to find a name with a specific quality than to find one that suits you and feels comfortable to the person you know yourself to be.

HOW HIS NAME NUMBERS STACK UP

His combination of Expression and Heart's Desire numbers creates a strong, driven, ambitious energy that is not always easy to control. Fortunately, his Personality number tempers it somewhat with compassion, empathy, and tolerance. Still, to have this much forceful energy may be a burden at times.

He will not be afraid to confront others and may provoke a few volatile encounters, especially in his younger years. (Although he values his own freedom, he may tend to control others.) The upside of this powerful energy is his ability to overcome obstacles and push himself well beyond the point where most people would have given up. He has courage, leadership qualities, and is highly

idealistic, but he is also realistic and practical.

He is independent and individualistic and may leave home to pursue his own path earlier than most. He will be a difficult and demanding boss, but an even more difficult subordinate. He is happiest working for himself or in a position with little oversight and interference.

His Personality number softens the edges of his Expression and Heart's Desire numbers considerably and makes him more approachable and likeable. Had his Personality been one of the more forceful numbers, such as a 4 or an 8, he would have found it more difficult to stay focused, and more challenging to maintain meaningful relationships.

He feels a sense of responsibility toward humankind, making him well suited for the legal fields, law enforcement, and engineering. Although it is likely he will be drawn to politics, or another field where he can influence change and satisfy his idealism, he is too direct to be a successful politician.

He is fiercely loyal and protective in his personal life, but he should guard against becoming jealous or possessive.

Let us look at each of the core numbers for more insight.

HE HAS A 1 EXPRESSION AND A 1 HEART'S DESIRE:

He is a natural leader, independent and individualistic. He is extremely ambitious, original, and courageous. He employs new and unproven methods. He is an explorer and an innovator. Openness to too many peripheral influences limits and frustrates him. He is self-reliant, confident, and energetic. He easily assumes the role of protector. He springs into action when leadership is needed. He possesses executive abilities and is most successful at owning or independently managing a business. He needs the freedom to make his decisions, based on his ideas. He also possesses the ability to influence the opinions of others.

The number 1 symbolizes the front-runner, pioneer, warrior, risk-taker, and daredevil. Generals, successful businesspeople, self-made millionaires, religious leaders, inventors, activists, and avant-garde artists are often born with a 1 Expression.

Strength and perseverance are central to his success. He must be willing to travel the frontiers of life, away from the beaten path. He possesses a great reserve of willpower that must be directed at his goals. He does not give up, but relentlessly pursues his aims.

He is quite opinionated. People tend to be inspired or repelled by his strong personality. He has great powers of concentration and the ability to visualize his goals, thus making them more

attainable. He stands up for his convictions and holds his ground. All these abilities enhance his chances of success in life.

There is a tendency to be self-centered. He can be domineering and, in the extreme, a bully. He can be highly critical of others, complaining that people lack the industry or determination he possesses. But this lack of understanding can alienate friends and family members from him. He must learn to control this tendency to maintain harmony in relationships. Once he is convinced of the inherent correctness of his ideas, he stubbornly -- and sometimes rigidly -- defends and propagates them. He must learn to avoid obstinacy and antagonism. He must cultivate balance, compassion, and perseverance.

Pride can be his downfall. He so powerfully identifies with his goals and ambitions; he sometimes refuses to see a potential flaw or weakness in his well-laid plans.

He possesses strength and determination, which, when applied to any endeavor he is committed to, will lead him to great success in life.

HIS PERSONALITY IS A 9

He has an impressive and aristocratic bearing. No matter how tall he is, he appears noble and upright. He is very much in control of the image he sends out to others. Many actors, dancers, and other performers have a 9 Personality Number. He is elegant, graceful, and charismatic. Many admire him. He has the kind of stature that pulls people to him or repels them intensely. Some are jealous of him and may seek to belittle him. He may encourage this to some extent by the amount of arrogance he radiates. This is a caution for all 9 Personalities -- they are sometimes aloof and hold themselves above the world. His challenge is to remain down to earth with his fellow man.

Conversely, he has a great compassion for humanity and wants to dedicate himself to improving the lot of others. He is better when dealing with the trials of the many than the trouble of a single person. He is more capable of working on the grand scale, addressing the needs of society, than on a one-to-one basis.

He is kind and sympathetic, helpful, and compassionate. Behind the controlled and calm facade, he is sensitive, vulnerable, and emotional.

He has excellent taste. There is a good deal of artistic talent in him that shows in his home environment and his clothing. He tends to see himself as a guardian of society, a benevolent leader, guiding and directing his community toward a better world.
