THE LIFE PATH

Jane, your Life Path number is 7

HOW YOUR LIFE PATH NUMBERS COMPARE

Your Life Path number is the most important influence in your chart. As such, their compatibility is very important to the well being of your relationship.

John and Jane, your Life Path Compatibility is 2 and 7

In this combination of numbers, intuition meets intelligence, sensitivity meets clinical research, and the heart meets the mind. It would be a challenge to find two more different archetypes than yours. John and Jane, you have a surprising relationship. Rarely do people with such different characteristics express even the slightest interest in each other. But when they do, the partnership is worth every effort. You almost certainly met under unusual circumstances, perhaps when you were both outside of your normal environment (I am guessing John, the 2, initially reached out to Jane). Potential pitfalls in this combination are generally experienced at the beginning of the relationship. There could be many challenges, including the inability to relate to your partner's way of thinking, feeling, or expressing emotion.

THE EXPRESSION

Your Expression number, calculated from your full name at birth, reveals the orientation or goal of your life. Some numerologists refer to this as your Destiny number because it represents a lifelong target at which you are aiming. Thus, the Expression number, to some extent, reveals the person you aim to be.

Your Expression is the most influential of the three characteristics that make up who you are. It is also the number with the most influence on your choice of career, although other aspects are important as well.

Jane, your Expression is 3



You are optimistic, inspiring, outgoing, and expressive. HOW YOUR EXPRESSION NUMBERS COMPARE

More than any other number in your chart, your Expression number reflects who you are as a whole person on a deep level (rather than the "face" you show to the world, described by your Personality number).

It cannot be over-emphasized how important it is to recognize that the same number in a different area of your chart will affect you differently. There may be times you read something that seems to directly contradict an earlier statement. Yet, if you take time to carefully think about the opposing information you might recognize that, being the complex individual you are, you carry the same contradictions. This is natural and true for all of us. You may excel at organization in one area of your life, while chaos rules in another. You may be tactful and sensitive in one setting, but direct

and confrontational in another.

Be aware that it is more difficult to overcome negative traits you recognize in yourself when they are found in this part of the chart, than when they are found under the Life Path description.

John and Jane, your Expression Compatibility is 7 and 3

Your combination of numbers in this part of the chart is particularly interesting. The differing natures of the 3 and 7 can make a relationship last for two weeks or help it remain exciting and powerful for a lifetime. If your relationship is stable and has existed for quite some time, you may well remain soul mates for life. If the relationship began recently and has already experienced considerable ups and downs, you might be in for a very rough ride. It is also quite common for this combination to turn from romance into a deep friendship soon after a romantic fall-out.

Jane (the 3) has a restless, energetic, unconventional mind that happily explores the boundaries of creativity and originality. Like a kaleidoscope, the mind of the 3 easily changes color and shape and enchants those around it. However, the 3 also prefers to stay on the surface, keeping things light and upbeat.

John (the 7) has a much more serious, but no less unconventional way of viewing life; they are an untiring seeker of truth and understanding, who finds great satisfaction in quiet moments of contemplation and soul searching. John thrives on the clarity and realizations that come from moments of inner/spiritual enlightenment.

Although you have quite different intellectual styles, you are both unconventional and not afraid to wander off the beaten path. You also differ in your needs and interests - but they are compatible. THE HEART'S DESIRE

The Expression number described above points to a more productive side of your life. HOW YOUR HEART'S DESIRE NUMBERS COMPARE

Compatibility of the Heart's Desire number is very important in a relationship. Few relationships last beyond the initial stage if these numbers are not harmonious.

John and Jane, your Heart's Desire Compatibility is 1 and 7

John and Jane, your compatibility in this area of the chart is unpredictable. Some relationships between a 1 (John) and 7 (Jane) thrive, while others hardly stand a chance.

The initial connection in this combination is usually intellectual - on a level where you relate and have plenty to share. Jane likely realized at an early age that they were "different" in some way. The 7 is intensely curious, challenging things others take for granted. It upends old concepts and understands the complexities underlying conventions the rest of us accept as the norm.

Although your attitudes differ in the way you approach life - John in a more aggressive, confrontational way and (Jane) in a more introspective manner, you are both happy to venture into new, strange, or unknown intellectual and spiritual territories. Both free thinkers, your differing perspectives create a spicy, captivating relationship.

It is in matters of the heart, feelings, and emotions where you might encounter trouble spots. Neither of you is eager to expose your inner self. You are both private, sensitive, and vulnerable, and do not wear your heart on your sleeve. You, John, because you recognize strength and endurance as your in-born assets, and Jane because you are comfortable keeping some distance from others.

Jane, you are attracted to John's strength and stability. John is the grounding force in your relationship, offering almost unconditional love and protection. You feel safe and secure in their love. John, you thrive on giving love, comfort, and protection. You are attracted to Jane's free spirit and the way their courage and curiosity brings excitement and growth to the relationship. The 5 (Jane) and the 6 (John) complement each other very well.

It is interesting to note that this type of partnership is somewhat rare. This is due to the initial distrust the 6 and the 5 must overcome when they first meet. They have little in common and usually do not reach out to bridge the gap. Therefore, although possible, love at first sight is rarely found in this combination.

When a 5 and 6 are drawn to each other, it is usually very physical and sensual. Once you connect, the attraction grows quickly and powerfully, overshadowing just about everything else in your lives. This physical attraction is a solid foundation and while many couples lose interest in their physical relationship after a period, your attraction should last and remain quite powerful. A physical attraction is particularly important to Jane, who is a sensual person by nature.

Once you have overcome any initial wariness, John will recognize there is much more substance to Jane than they initially noticed; and Jane will prove that, despite an early reluctance to commit, they are loyal and trustworthy. The belief that those who embrace change and adapt to new circumstances easily do not have the ability to commit is proven wrong when applied to the 5. In fact, John is less likely to cheat than most people.

In contrast, John could become a source of frustration or jealousy for Jane because, although John easily commits and is loyal, it is in their nature to give love freely and generously to all; they are quick with hugs and concern for other people simply because they have a lot of love to give. Teaching, healing, and counseling (even if they are not part of a career) are major ingredients of the 6, and Jane needs avenues to express them.

The most difficult challenge John may have to overcome is Jane's extremely social personality. For Jane to be happy, they must live a dynamic life full of change, impulsive decisions, social activities, and travel. With some exaggeration, you might say John prefers to stay home while Jane loves going to the pub. To maintain a successful relationship, you will both need to accept your differences while making a united effort to support and nourish your relationship.

MATURITY NUMBER

Your Maturity number indicates an underlying wish or desire that gradually surfaces at around age 30 to 35. A direction begins to emerge as you gain a better understanding of yourself. With this self-knowledge comes a greater awareness of who you are, and the direction you want to set for your life.

As you mature, your appreciation for the arts and beauty in any form will also increase. It is quite possible that you will be actively involved in the arts, if that is not already the case, often as a benefactor.

If you have few 9s in your chart, or none at all, you will gain a sense of your personal place among the human race. You will feel you belong and that you have provided something of lasting value for the future. If you already have several 9s in your chart, especially among the core numbers, you will have to guard against arrogance, aloofness, and alienation.

Jane, your Maturity number is 1



As you mature, you will find yourself needing an increasing amount of independence and individuality. You will fight harder for the recognition and rewards you feel you deserve and will be less willing to accept failure or limitations in any form. Jane, your drive and determination will grow as does your ability to take charge.

If there are already several 1s in your chart, especially among the core numbers, you will have to strive to avoid becoming bossy, rigid, stubborn and selfish. A person who allows these characteristics to run free will become bullish and lonely later in life. If there are not many 1s in your chart, the influence of the Maturity Number will help you to establish your independence and success. From this foundation, you will have an active, adventurous, and exciting latter part of life.

HOW YOUR MATURITY NUMBERS COMPARE

Your Maturity number becomes more dominant with age. The texts below become increasingly important after about age 40.

John and Jane, your Maturity Compatibility is 9 and 1

The numbers 1 and 9 are at opposite ends of the numerology spectrum and are considered somewhat opposing influences. This could translate into an inability to understand one another. In many areas of life, you may be so different that you are unable to relate to your partner's perspective. Although not a necessary component for friendship, shared views on the most important aspects of life are necessary for a successful romantic relationship. This combination has a much better chance of surviving if both of you have the number 2 and/or 6 among your other core numbers.

Both John and Jane are likely a bit egocentric and can be somewhat arrogant at times (at least in this area of your chart). However, while we have all heard opposites attract, they also repel when they get too close.

There are no easy solutions or foolproof guidelines that work here. If you have been together for a long time and your love and commitment are strong, you have weathered your differences and found your way to a loving partnership. If your relationship is recent, focus on your heart and your unconditional love for each other. The best advice I can offer is to accept and respect your partner just the way they are, and do not expect to influence or change them.
